PAINTING PAINTING PAINTING STATES OF THE STA

This one-off project will explore the connection between creativity and wellbeing through an evening of collaborative painting with Bristol icon, Big Jeff.

During lockdown, Big Jeff - renowned for having attended over 4,000 gigs in Bristol, began painting as a way of managing his mental health. He says:

'I began painting as a way of dealing with lots of difficult emotions and my struggle to deal with the world around me. It came as a natural and cathartic release. Art for me is about creating space for myself and using my creativity to find my voice.'

Big Jeff is interested in exploring creativity and wellbeing with 8 young people from OTR through this one-off workshop. Together, along with Arts Works facilitator Tilda, you'll have the opportunity to experiment with expression through different painting techniques with the aim of creating a big collaborative collage piece. 1:1s with Tilda will also be offfered after the workshop if wanted.

This project aims to primarily reach young people who identify as being:

- Disabled
- Neurodivergent
- A person of colour
- LGBTO+

- A young man
- Care experienced / in care
- A refugee
- An asylum seeker
